

Fall Protection Awareness

Duration:

2—3 hours

Number of students:

Maximum: 20

Minimum: 5

Recommended Audience:

Any individual who will be assigned to a jobsite where fall hazards exist, and those individuals who need to become familiar with OSHA/MIOSHA Standards for fall protection and harness awareness.

Registration and Pre-Course Instructions:

All students are to call GLSTC and reserve a spot in class.

Instruction Method:

Classroom based, instructor led, work props and group interaction.

Course Topics:

Attendees will learn the OSHA/MIOSHA requirements for fall protection, fall hazard identification, how to select the proper protective system and the importance of pre-planning for fall protection. Topics covered will include general requirements for fall protection, use and application of specialized fall protection systems, inspection and maintenance of fall protection systems, pre-planning techniques to eliminate fall exposures and rescue considerations.

Course Wrap-up:

- Clarify points of concern.
- Hands-on use of equipment.
- Summarize the topics covered during the course.

Assessment of Students:

All students will be evaluated by the instructor as to knowledge of the course and hands-on components of the training. General awareness certification will be issued based on attendees understanding of the information presented during course.

Records to be Maintained:

Course completion cards will be issued after successful completion of the class.

Renewal:

Completed training will be valid until employer has reason to believe that changes have occurred in the workplace or with the employees knowledge regarding fall protection systems or equipment. Retraining would be required at that time as stated in MIOSHA Standard Part 45 1926.503(c).
